In Ghana, women hold less than 15% of parliamentary seats, and young people under 25 represent a significant portion of the population. Despite their demographic weight, **women and youth face persistent barriers to political engagement** and leadership opportunities.

The WYDE Political Parties Project works to foster a more inclusive democracy, ensuring women and youth are not only participants but leaders in shaping political processes. Through capacity building, legal and policy reform, research, and multiparty cooperation, the project provides targeted support to strengthen political inclusion.

The Multiparty, Multi-Country, Single-Party Approach.

WYDE Political Parties operates through three complementary approaches to maximize political inclusivity and institutional impact:

- Multiparty: Strengthening cross-party dialogue and inclusivity across ideological lines.
- **Single-Party:** Supporting internal party reforms for greater youth & women's participation.
- Multi-Country: Engaging regional networks for knowledge exchange and shared best practices.

Capacity Building & Leadership Development

- Leadership training for female Members of Parliament.
- Mentorship and networking through Women's Breakfast Meetings foster peer learning across party lines.
- Financial management and media skills workshops for female MPs.
- Media Training for Female Parliamentarians.

Policy Reform & Advocacy

- Policy brief writing workshops using case studies on political violence.
- National conference to address violence against women in politics, that bring together MPs, civil society, and policy experts to develop practical strategies for reform.
